Sub: NABH Accreditation

Dear Sir/ Madam,

National Accreditation Board for Hospitals and Healthcare Providers (NABH) provides accreditation services since 2006. NABH accreditation for hospitals is based on defined standard. At present NABH provides accreditation to:

- 1. Hospitals (having beds more than 50)
- 2. Small Health Care Organisation (SHCO having beds between 20-50). Eye Centres falls into the category of SHCO
- 3. Dental Centres (Official announcement would follow soon) centre can in meantime follow SHCO Standards
- 4. Blood Banks/ Blood Centres and Transufusion Centres

NABH procedure requires a hospital to implement the standard for atleast three months before making an application. This is required so that there are evidences of compliance with standards. However, CGHS has given a timeline of making application to NABH before July 12, 2009, keeping this in view, NABH will accept application from hospitals even before three months of implementation and will give time to hospitals for completing the specified process of NABH. This will help hospitals in meeting CGHS timeline.
