1. The fees shall be paid in USD. Invoice in this regard shall be generated and sent to the hospital.
2. The accreditation fee does not include expenses on travel (Flight Tickets, Travel Insurance as per norms of the respective country, cost towards VISA arrangements), lodging/ boarding of assessors, and will be borne by the hospital.
3. Self-Assessment Toolkit duly filled in along with the application form is to be submitted by the hospital online.
4. The accreditation, once granted will be valid for four years incase of Hospital accredited under 5th edition and in other cases 3 years. The hospital may apply for renewal as per the NABH policy.
5. 10% discount will be admissible in case hospitals pay the accreditation fee for the whole accreditiaion cycle in advance in one instalment.
6. The surveillance visit will be planned during the mid cycle of accreditation which is usually between 18 - 24 months based on the accreditation cycle.
7. NABH may call for an un-announced visit, which could be a Surprise Assessment or based on any concern or any serious incident reported upon by any individual or organisation or media.
